Windows Server 2025, the latest Long-Term Servicing Channel (LTSC) release, introduces advanced security, new Azure hybrid features, a high-performance platform for your existing apps and Al workloads, and a modernized Windows Server experience.

- **Cloud agility anywhere**: Adapt quickly across hybrid, cloud and edge. Easier to connect to Azure Arc to bridge on-premises and cloud-based servers and deliver Azure capabilities to your on-premises servers.
- High-performance, Al-ready infrastructure: Windows Server 2025 lights up new
 possibilities with compute, performance, and storage enhancements. New GPU
 partitioning across VMs with live migration and failover clustering built to support Al
 workloads. Reduce time spent on network setup, upgrades, and management tasks.

For hybrid innovation, onboarding machines in your System Center Virtual Machine Manager (SCVMM) managed datacenters to Azure Arc is simplified with <u>Azure Arc-enabled SCVMM</u>. In addition to at-scale Arc onboarding, it also enables you to manage the lifecycle of the machines in your datacenter in a self-service fashion from Azure.

Office LTSC 2024

Like earlier perpetual versions of Office, Office LTSC 2024 will include only a subset of the value found in Microsoft 365 Apps, building on the features included in past releases. New features for Office LTSC 2024 include: **new meeting creation options and search enhancements in Outlook**, dozens of **new Excel features and functions including Dynamic Charts and Arrays**; and improved **performance**, **security**, and **accessibility**. Office LTSC 2024 will not ship with Microsoft Publisher, <u>which is being retired</u>, or with the Microsoft Teams app, which is available to download separately.

Office LTSC 2024 will have new prices across all commercial channels, including SPLA.

Q. Will Remote Desktop Services (RDS) SAL prices increase in 2025?

No, there will not be a percentage price increase for RDS SAL in 2025; however, actual prices may change due to FX adjustment based on location and currency.

Q. Will Project and Visio prices increase in 2025?

No, there will not be a percentage price increase for Project and Visio in 2025; however, actual prices may change due to FX adjustment based on location and currency.

Q. Why are Dynamics prices increasing?

Microsoft has kept SPLA pricing consistent for 5+ years for its Dynamics offerings. Considering this, Microsoft is increasing the SPLA prices of Dynamics offerings as detailed above.
